The **LET** project, promoted since 2010 by the Cariplo Foundation and developed by AIM Associazione Interessi Metropolitan and LAND Milano, has a twofold target: first, to show a complete frame of all the territorial developments through an analysis that maps all the ongoing and expected projects, and on the other hand, to develop solid proposals for the promotion and use of these spaces, looking towards a territorial diffusion of Expo2015. The project consists of interventions in the rural landscape via the redevelopment of degraded landscapes, such as small reforestations, improvement of water ways and valorization of existing pedestrian and cycle paths. It provides ten circular cycling routes, from 12 to 36 km long, for people to enjoy and get to know and promote not just farmlands, forests and waterways, but also historic towns, farms and churches in their local communities.

“**LET4 - Water and farms lands**” is the route weaving through the Parco Agricolo Sud Milano, in a water-rich land, starting from the Naviglio Grande canal at Gaggiano, where the LET begins. The route stretches over about 30 km to unveil Lombardy's farmland; from water meadows to historic farmhouses, from former quarries converted into lakes now hosting birds to small hamlets isolated in the middle of rice fields. Food and facilities are available in towns and farmhouses.
